
NSP Snapshots Study

59 service contacts completed survey during February 2020 snapshot

21 service contacts completed survey during June 2020 snapshot

36% think drugs are harder to access

February 2020: 5% identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander

had a parent born overseas (one or both)




June 2020:
