

## Since Stage 4 COVID-19 restrictions began,

25% use decreased



Of which: 36% unable to afford 29% started treatment

39% of contacts reported that their drug use remained stable

33% use increased



Of which: 18% more disposable income 32% drug of poor quality 50% other



of contacts had experienced interactions with police

Of which:

21% nothing happened

37% were issued a warning



## Some were fined:

- 19% for not wearing masks
- 13% being out of the house for a non-essential reason
- 13% for breaching curfew
- 10% being further than 5km from home
